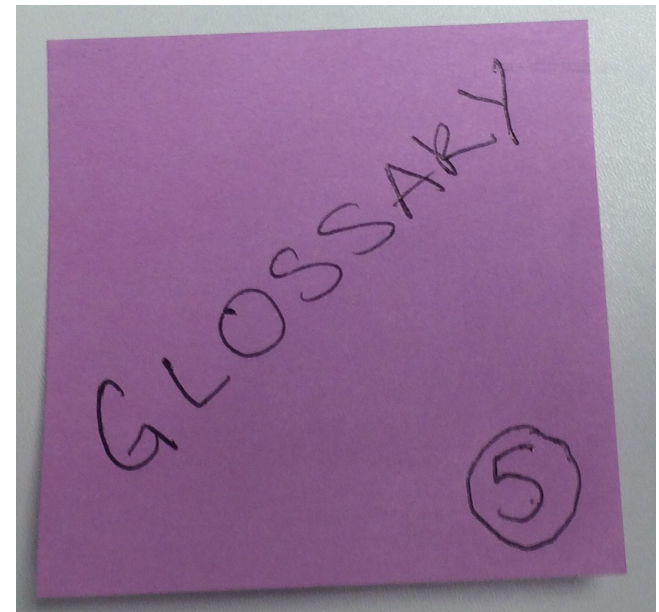

# What is a Project?



- A project is a temporary endeavor undertaken to create a unique product or service. (Project Management Institute (PMI))
- Projects utilizing University Systems (IT) resources use the **University Systems Project Management Methodology** and approval processes.
- Projects and resources approved by the University Systems Project Review Committee (PRC)



# Project Management

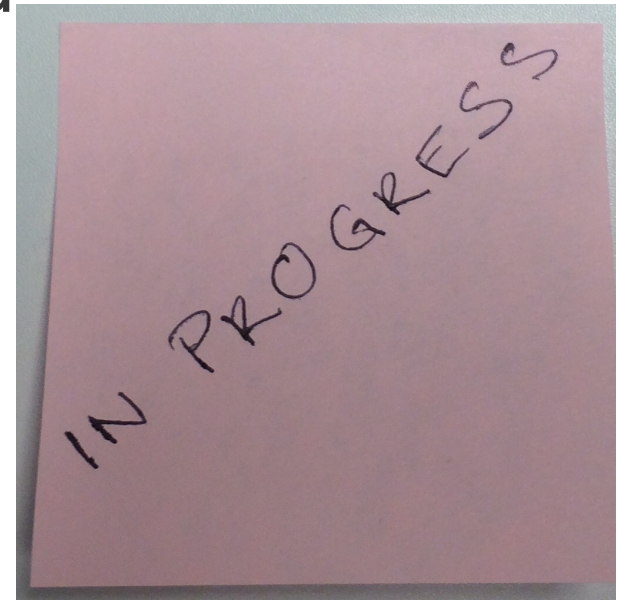


- 95-98% of active projects are traditional “waterfall” projects
- We initiate and plan, then gain approval before execution
- Monitoring and controlling begin at planning and end when the closeout report is complete
- Minimize changes, emphasis on up-front decision-making

# Agile



- Agile projects are characterized by rapid evolution of the product with an incremental and **iterative approach**
- Continuous releases and improvements to the product
- Popular methodology is **Scrum**, which details how agile practices can be implemented
  - Focus on roles and responsibilities
  - Meetings, such as "**scrum**" and "**sprint planning, review, and retrospective**"

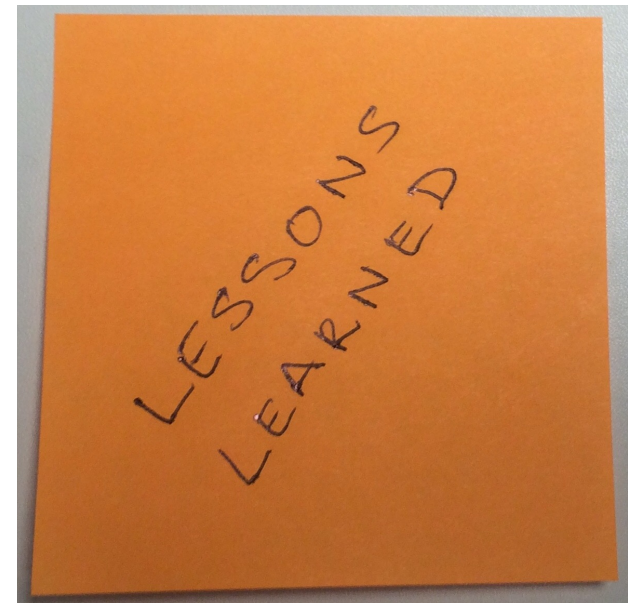




# Agile



- Started using Scrum framework in 2011 with success
- Related projects and initiatives continued to follow Agile ideals and challenges surfaced
- Project Plans lacked key information for Project Review Committee:
  - Overall resource impact
  - Incidental resources required
  - Scope control strategies
  - Funding needs



# What do we love?



- Personal, team accountability
- Focused work, less context switching
- Increased functional and stakeholder engagement
- Knowledge transfer
- Focus on **value** for the client
- Team space and co-location



# Challenges to Overcome



- Resource contention, competing priorities
- Can be hard to keep up if a day or meeting is missed
- Distractions
- When to use agile (cost of change is too high)
- Scrum/Agile training
- Agile project management practices are not well-defined in our methodology
