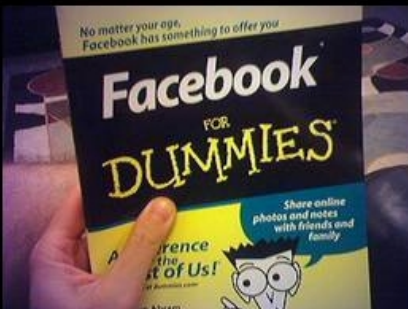

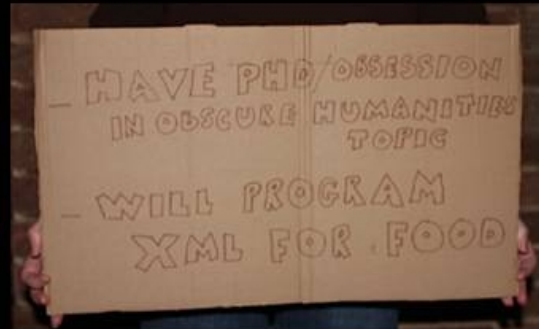

Research that utilizes computational tools, techniques, and methodologies to explore people, their interactions, their history, their cultural practices, and all the other things that make us human.

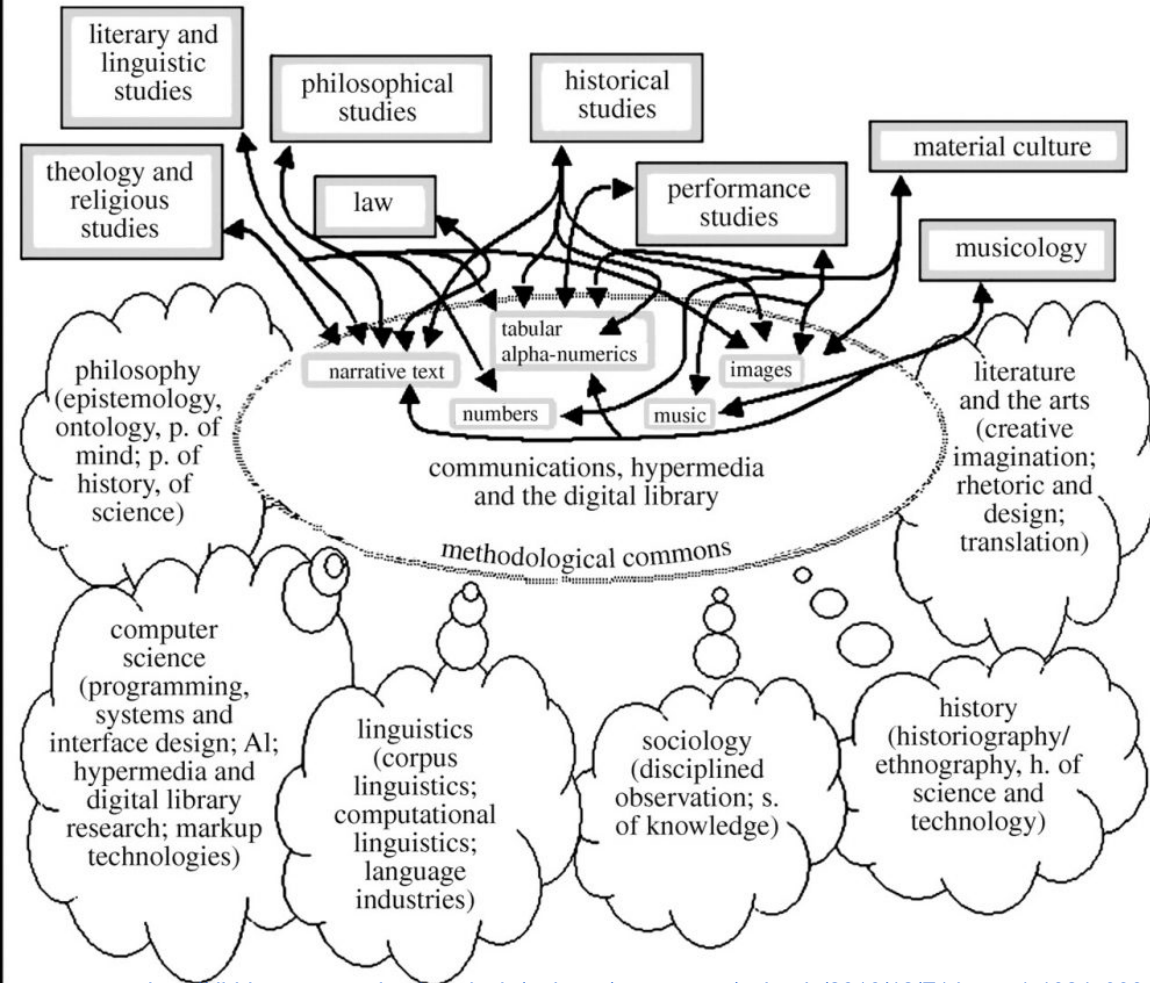

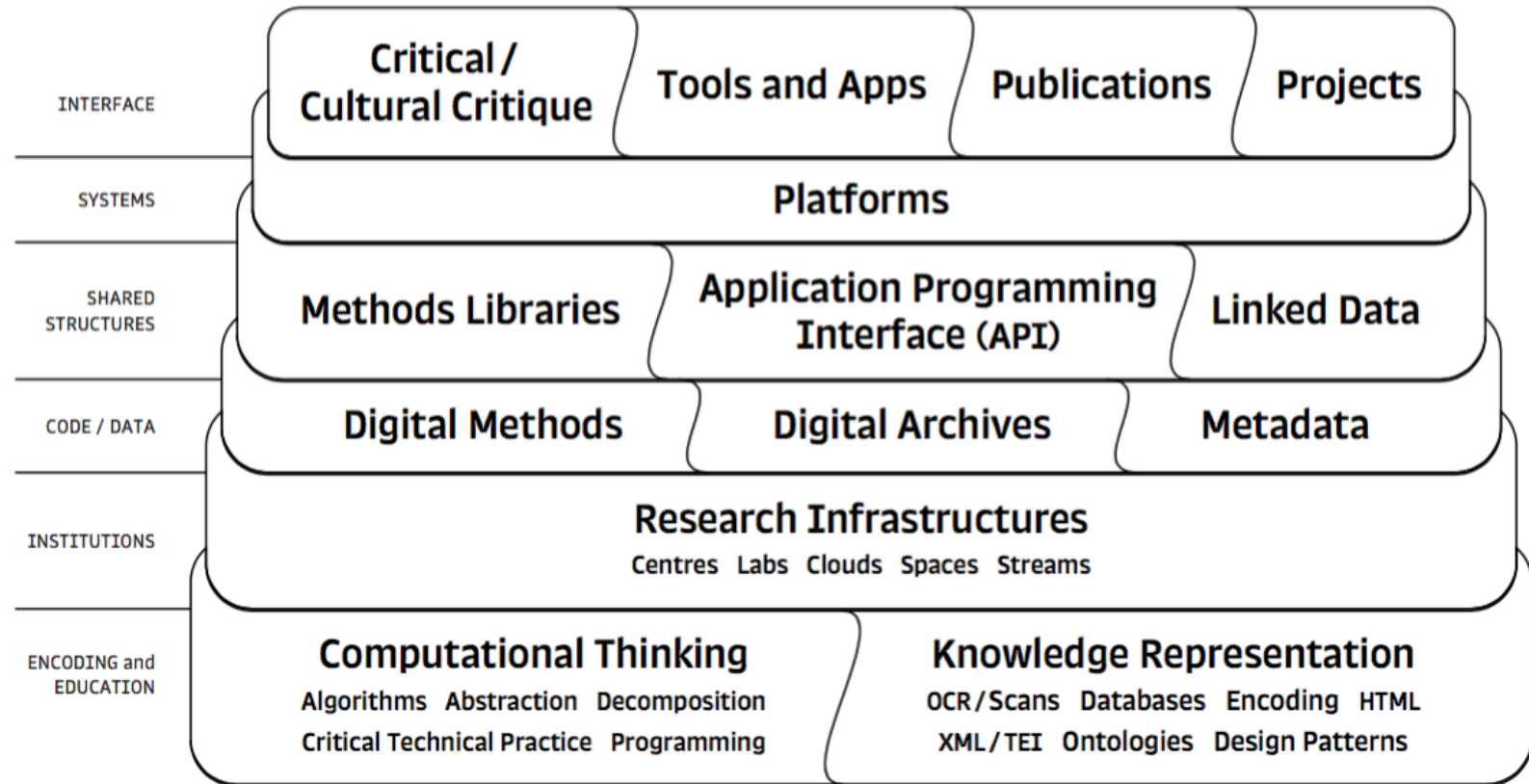


DH According to Willard McCarty and Harold Short.

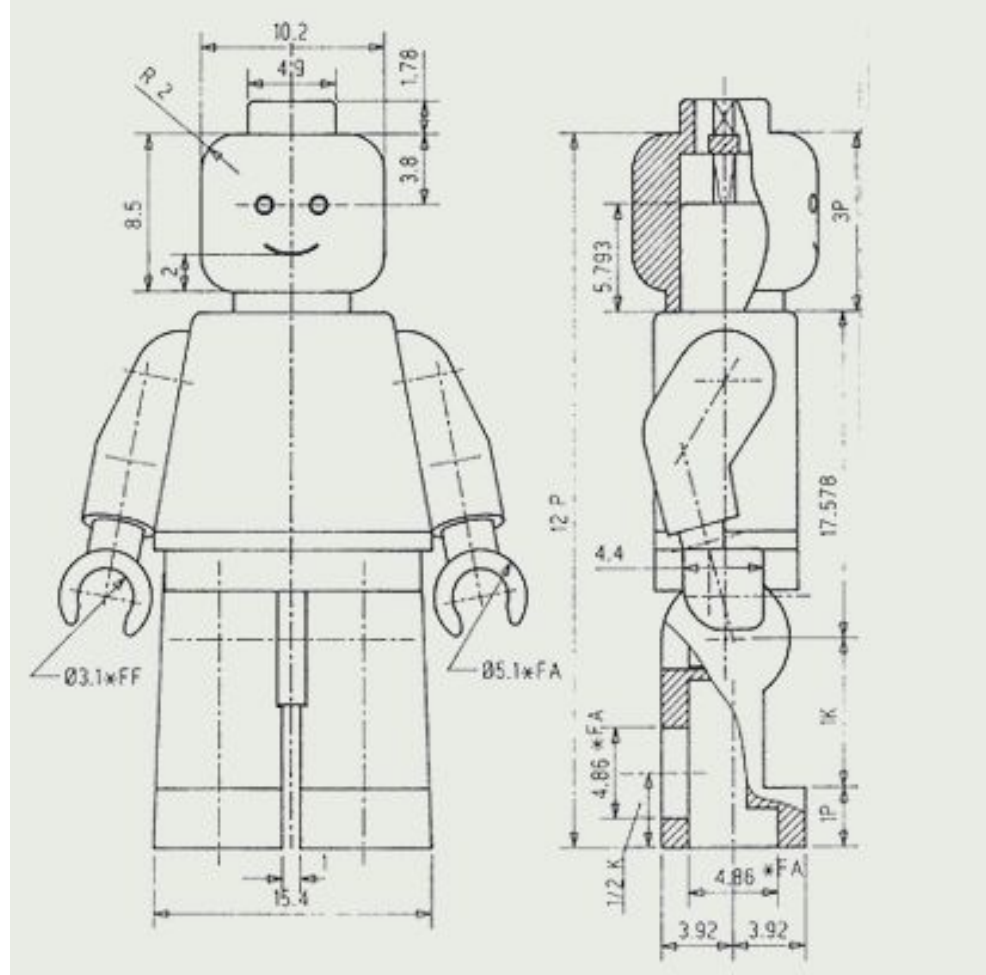

What is a DH Project?

From Emory Centre for Digital Scholarship:

Types of Digital Humanities Projects:

- those that produce humanistic knowledge (e.g., [building digital exhibits](#), [text encoding](#))
- those that discover existing knowledge (e.g., by [digitizing and making available materials to other people](#), or [crowdsourcing the transcription of audio](#))
- those that analyze knowledge (e.g., [text mining](#), [mapping the flow of historical letters](#))
- those that preserve knowledge (e.g., [bit curation](#))

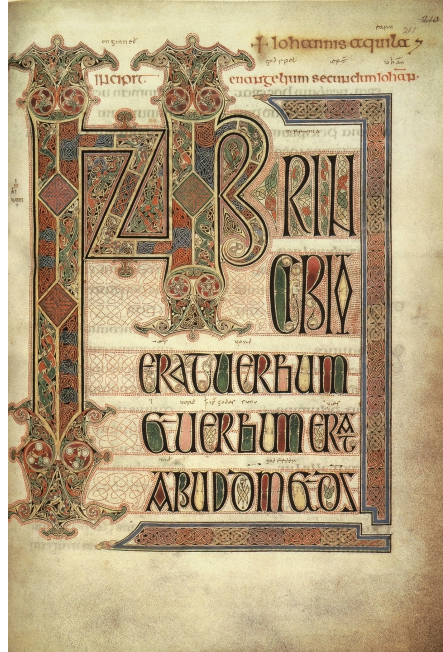

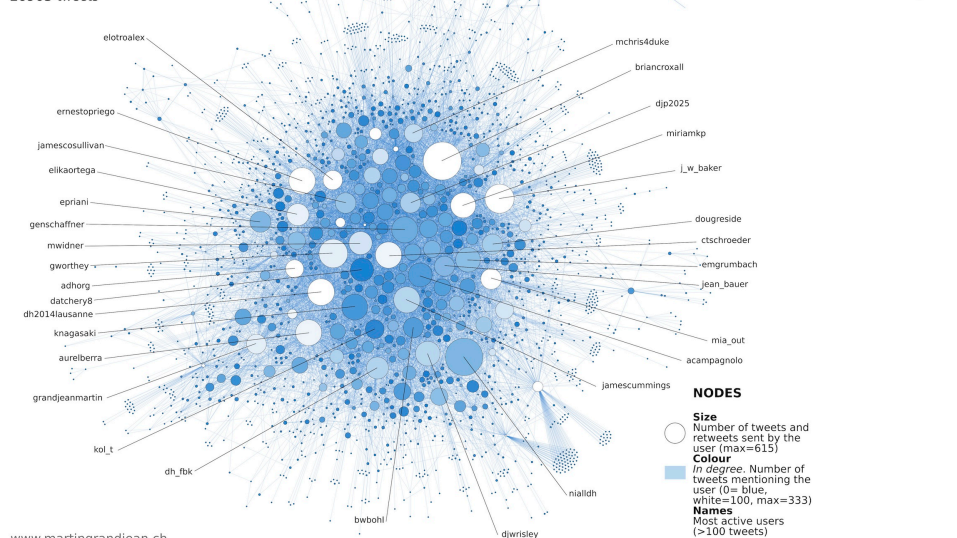

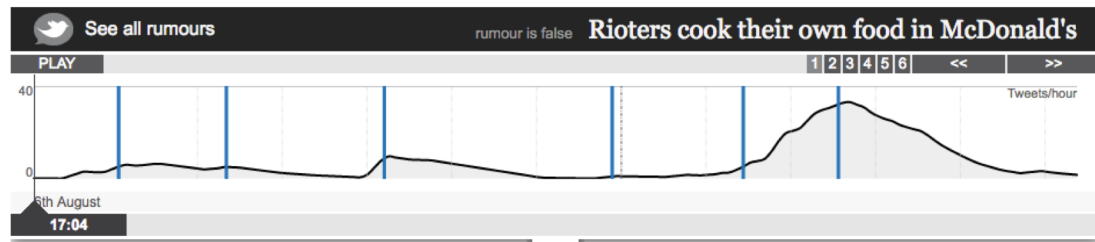

How the rumour unfolded

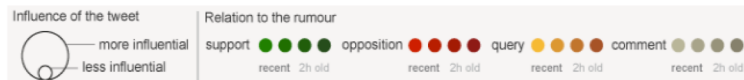
